Walsh, 11th Battalion, I am now in receipt of advice which shows that he was wounded in action in France on 27.8.18, and died the same day at 01st Casualty Clearing Station, from the effects of shell wound right leg and thigh. He was buried in Daours Communal Cemetery Extension, 2½ miles West of Corbie.
